



Reflection Questions

1. Read Joshua 24:1-14. Joshua recounts all of the false gods that their ancestors and the people that used to occupy the land served. By doing so, Joshua calls out the false gods, and calls them to worship the one, true God. What are the false gods around you? What false God are you most tempted to worship? Why?

2. Looking at your answers from question #1, which false god are you most likely to serve? In Joshua 24:16-28, Joshua really pushes the Israelites. Joshua recognizes their propensity to worship false gods. Do the same thing for your life. Which false god to you have the biggest propensity towards?

3. Read Joshua 24:14. Keeping in mind your answer from question #2, what practical way(s) can you serve God is sincerity and faithfulness?

4. What is your biggest take away from this sermon series through the book of Joshua? What has God done in and through you through this portion of His Word? Take some time to reflect, then write it down, so as not to forget the good work that God has done in and through you. If you feel comfortable doing so, share these things with a Christian friend or your accountability partner.
