

11/20/22 - Week 5 – 1 Samuel 12 Leaving a Legacy of Faith

Reflection Questions

- 1. If you've been following along since week 1, write down those names of kids in your life and pray for them. If you haven't followed along, where are you in the scope of parenting? - 5. What is your biggest take away from this sermon series? What did God teach you? Do you feel led to put anything into action? If so, what, and what practical step(s) do you need to take to be obedient to what God has led you to do? Who can keep you accountable to accomplishing this?
