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Reflecting on God's Word

Getting Started

- Take some time to read over John 9:1-41 and pray.
- Have you ever read or heard about this before? What stood out to you as we were talking about it?
- What surprised you as we talked about it?
- As you reflect on this part of God's Word, put yourself in the place of the crowd in this story. How do you think you have reacted? Why?
- Take some time to pray for those in your life who do not know Jesus as their personal Lord and Savior. Ask that God would give you opportunities to talk with them, and for you to be able to tell them your story of what Jesus has done for you.

Diving In

1. Take some time to prayerfully think through your story. What were you like before you came to Christ? How has God transformed your life?
2. Are you ever tempted to edit your story somehow? If so, do you tend to make your story more or less sinful? Why do you think that is?
3. What are some natural ways your story could come up in conversation?
4. What stops you from telling your story of how Jesus has changed your life? Why is that?
5. As you think through your story, who could you most naturally share it with this week? Spend some time in prayer, asking that God would give you the opportunity to do so.

Applying the Scripture

What are your biggest takeaways from this passage of God's Word?

- What practical step(s) do you need to implement in your life to apply what God has taught you in this passage of Scripture?
- How would applying this affect your life and your relationship with the Lord?
- Who can you ask to keep you accountable to applying this to your life?

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
