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Reflecting on God's Word

Getting Started

- Take some time to read over Matthew 28:1-17 and pray.
- Have you ever read or heard about this before? What stood out to you as we were talking about it?
- What surprised you as we talked about it?
- As you reflect on this part of God's Word, put yourself in the place of the people of this story. How do you think you have reacted? Why?

Diving In

1. Read Matthew 28:4. Some people don't do anything when they hear about the good news of Jesus. Have you ever had a season of your life when that was the case for you? If so, what caused you to start taking Jesus' death and resurrection seriously? Who in your life has heard the Gospel, but hasn't started following Jesus? How can you remember to pray for them, and invite them to follow Jesus?
2. Read Romans 12:1-2. As we talked about in the message, worship isn't just singing at church, but surrendering your whole life over to God. Is there anything that you are struggling to surrender to God during this season of your life? If so, what, and what step(s) do you need to take next to hand that over to God?
3. Read Matthew 28:10. Some haven't yet heard about the good news of Jesus Christ. Who in your life hasn't heard yet, and how can you prayerfully tell them about the Gospel?
4. Read Matthew 28:11. Instead of leaning in to the message of Jesus, some of the guards sought others' opinions of how to react to what had happened. When you're struggling to know what to do, is your natural inclination to seek others' opinions, or God's? How can you better prioritize God's Word instead of others' words?
5. Read Matthew 28:17. It's difficult to believe, but even after witnessing Jesus being raised from the dead, there were still some who doubted. Why do you think this is? Have you ever struggled with doubt?

Applying the Scripture

What are your biggest takeaways from this passage of God's Word?

- What practical step(s) do you need to implement in your life to apply what God has taught you in this passage of Scripture?
- How would applying this affect your life and your relationship with the Lord?
- Who can you ask to keep you accountable to applying this to your life?

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
