4/10/22 - Week 63 – Luke 20:19-47

More than Meets the Eye

In this passage of God's Word, we see religious leaders attempting to discredit Jesus by stumping Him with questions that are very difficult to answer. Jesus answers these questions, though, and the religious leaders no longer dared to ask Him any questions. These answers that Jesus has teaches us far more than just the answers to the questions that the religious leaders ask. Jesus' answers teach us that:

Reflection Questions

1. Had you ever heard this taught before? What stood out to you?
2. Even though there is far more to learn from this passage than just the answers to the religious leaders' questions, did Jesus' answers to their questions surprise you? Did you learn anything new through Jesus' answers to their questions?
3. Through looking at this entire passage, we see that it is clear that there is far more to take to heart than just the answers to the religious leaders' questions. Of the 3 things that we highlighted about this passage, which one stood out to you most, and why?
4. What is your biggest take away about how this passage affects your life? What do you need to work on? Who can you share this with and ask you to keep you accountable to accomplishing this?
