

4/17/22 - Week 64 – Luke 24:36-49 Experiencing the Risen King

In this passage of God's Word we see Jesus appearing to His disciples after His resurrection. At first, they are in a state of disbelief. However, after the disciples experience Jesus first hand, Jesus then takes the opportunity to teach them what has happened, and what will happen. Reflection Questions

1. It took living alongside Jesus and experiencing Him personally for the disciples to realize who Jesus was and that He had risen from the dead. How well do you personally experience Him every day? What would help you to do that better? What would help you grow in your relationship with God?

2. The disciples had to experience Jesus firsthand in order to hear from Him. Have you ever had a season of your life where you had heard of others' experience with Jesus, but you hadn't really ever personally experienced life with Jesus? What eventually led you to live with Jesus as your *personal* Lord and Savior, and not just through others' experiences?
