

# 9/26/21 - Week 39 — Luke 13:1-9 Why do bad things happen to good people?

In this passage of God's Word, we see some people bringing up a tragedy to Jesus. Jesus uses this as a teaching moment for these people. By taking a close look at what Jesus is teaching them, we too can learn what Jesus is teaching. Specifically, we see Jesus teaching that we should...

### Realize:

- 1. Our life \_\_\_\_\_ are not equal to our standing with God Luke 3:1-5, Matt. 5:45, John 9:1-3
- 2. We are saved by \_\_\_\_\_ through faith Luke 13:3, 5, Eph. 2:8-9, Acts 2:38, Titus 3:5
- 3. God is merciful, yet \_\_\_\_\_ Luke 13:6-9, Rom. 2:4, Ps. 89:14, Is. 30:18

### **Reflection Questions**

1. The common mindset of Israelites, during the time of Jesus' ministry, was that bad things happened to people because they sinned, and good things happened to people because of their righteousness. Jesus corrects this mindset in this passage of Scripture. Do you ever struggle with having that mindset? If so, are there any specific sins or behaviors that especially stick out to you?

2. At the beginning of this passage of Scripture, some people tell Jesus of a heinous crime that Pilate committed against some Galilean Jews; but instead of getting riled up, blaming people, and stirring up contentiousness against Rome, Jesus uses this moment to lead people towards God. How could you learn from Jesus' example here? Are there issues that normally get you riled up, that you could instead point people towards Jesus? Be specific. Who can keep you accountable to this?

3. In Luke 13:6-9 Jesus tells a parable teaching that God is merciful, yet just. In what aspect of your life are you most grateful for God's mercy? How could you communicate that to the people God has put in your life?
