Diving In

1. Read Acts 4:1-7. What practical step(s) can you take to be filled with the Holy Spirit?

2. In Acts 4:15-22 Peter and John prioritize God's will over the Jewish leader's will. In your life, whose will (your own, a relative's, a friend's, ect.) are you most likely to prioritize over God's will? Why is that, and what can you do to make sure that you always prioritize God's will above all else?

3. Read Acts 4:29-30. Here, the believers pray that God would continue work and give them boldness. Spend some time in prayer, asking that God would do the same in your life. Jot down anything that the Lord brings to your mind.
