

Things to Pray for:

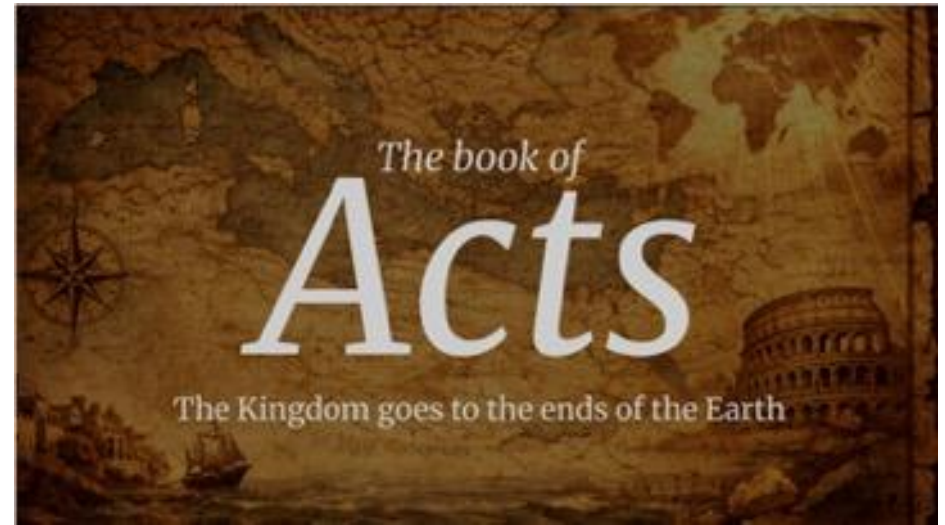
CHURCH FAMILY NEEDS: Please continue to pray for Milanna and her difficulty with breathing and swallowing.

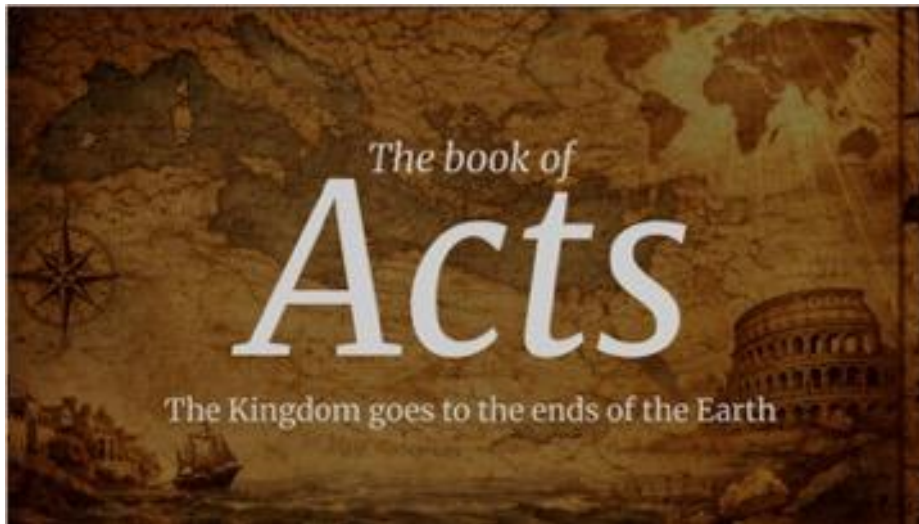
Opportunities to Help

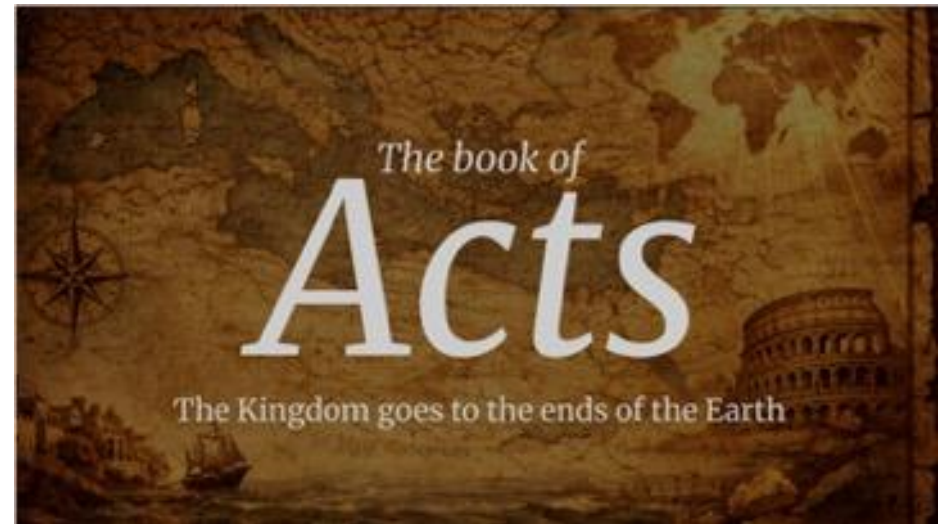
