

Things to Pray for:

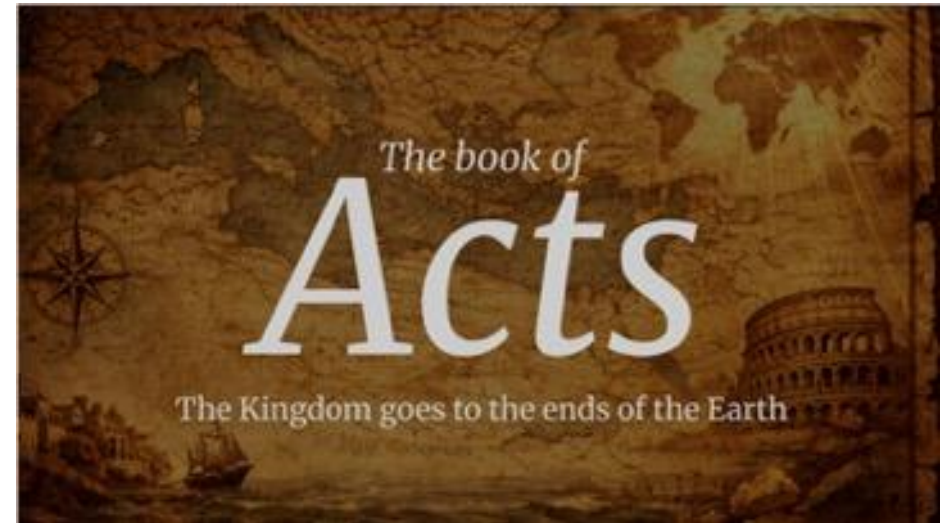
CHURCH FAMILY NEEDS: Please continue to pray for Milanna and her difficulty with breathing and swallowing.

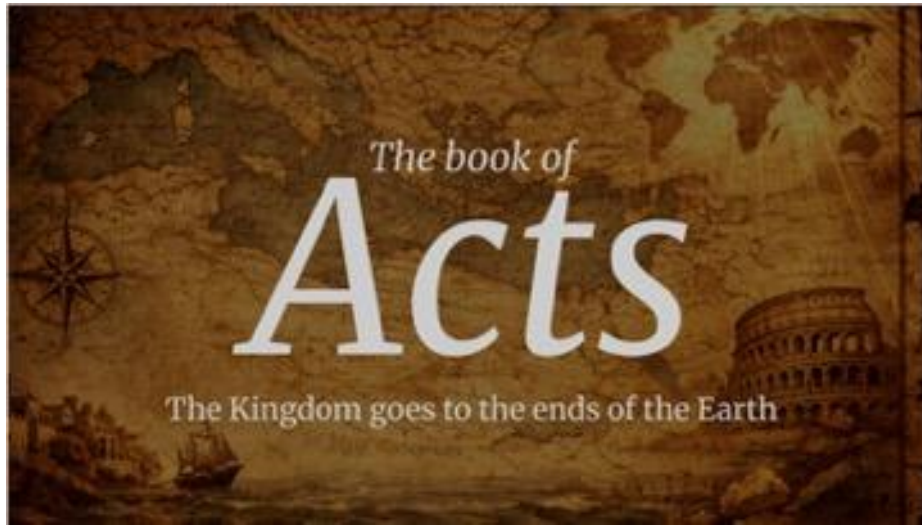
Opportunities to Help

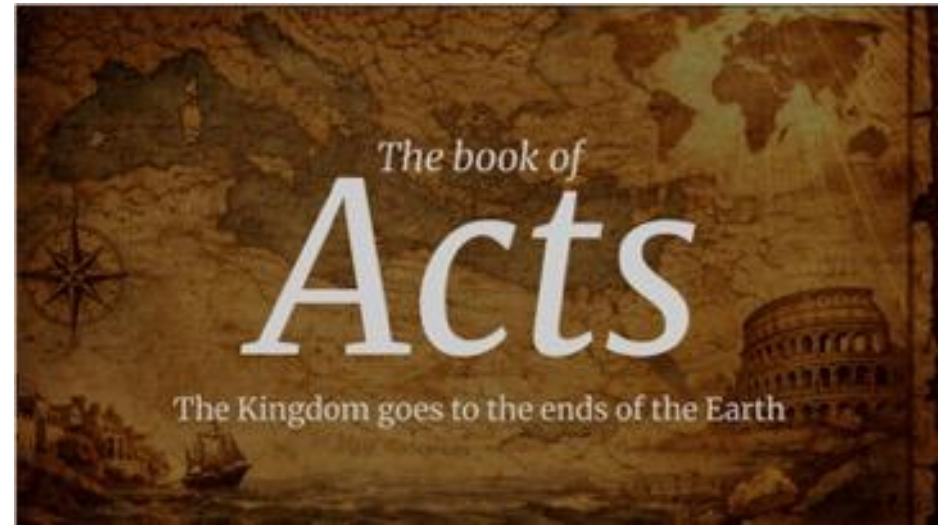

Reflecting on God's Word

Getting Started

- Take some time to read over Acts 5:17-42 and pray.
- Have you ever read or heard about this before? What stood out to you as we were talking about it?
- As you think about this sermon series through the book of Acts, what observation do you have?
- Looking back on your life, was there ever a time where you feel like you missed out on what God had for you? What factored into that, and how can you make sure that doesn't happen again?

Diving In

1. If we're not going to miss out on what God has for us, it is essential that we are founded on God's Word. How well are you founded on God's Word, and what can you do to ensure that you're growing in that area for your life?
2. The religious leaders from this part of God's Word let their selfish desires and emotions get the best of them, to the point where they missed out on what God had for them. How often does that happen in your life? What emotions typically get the best of you, and how can your surrender that to the Lord?
3. Read Philippians 4:5. Being reasonable is getting less and less popular, yet God's Word makes it clear that it is essential to have as a believer. How reasonable are you, and how could you grow in that area of your life?

- What practical step(s) do you need to implement in your life to apply what God has taught you in this passage of Scripture?
